APPELLATION

Dundee Hills, Willamette Valley, Oregon

VINEYARD COMPOSITION

The Single Acre Syrah is grown on Jory soil at a lower elevation on our Estate, allowing for optimal ripening. Clone 10, originally from Pont-de-la-Maye, France, is co-planted with a small amount of Viognier.

VARIETAL COMPOSITION

94% Syrah and 6% Viognier.

ÉLEVAGE

The Syrah was co-fermented with a small percentage of Viognier in stainless steel tanks to enhance aromatic lift and deepen color. Following fermentation, the wine was aged for 18 months in French oak barrels, 25% of which were new French oak.

NOTES FROM THE WINEMAKER

The 2023 Single Acre Syrah opens with bright aromas of violet and blackberry, layered with subtle savory and earthy tones. On the palate, this wine delivers a juicy, succulent profile supported by plush, round tannins. Layers of ripe plum and cassis unfold alongside hints of leather and a burst of just-picked blackberries. A gentle touch of oak lends structure and lift, guiding the wine to a long, satisfying finish.

VINTAGE OVERVIEW

The 2023 growing season brought steady warmth and balanced conditions across the Northwest. A cool start to spring delayed budbreak into late May, followed by a mild to warm summer that supported even ripening. September offered a focused harvest window with clean fruit and excellent flavor development. The vintage produced wines with generous aromatics, vibrant fruit, and refined textures that speak to the harmony of the season.
