WINEMAKER'S NOTES

This Red Blend is serious and elegant. Aromatic notes open with brambly red fruit, clove and star anise. The tannins have a defined presence on the palate that support flavors of dark red plums, cassis, and exotic spice.

VINTAGE OVERVIEW

In 2019, the abundance of snow in February provided ample soil moisture, leading the season into a normal and timley bud break. A warm spring created excellent conditions for canopy growth and early fruit development. Temperatures were mild in the summer, followed by cooler fall temperatures which were ideal for maintaining acidity and developing beautiful fruit flavors and aromas.
